Mission Statement

Through the gift of a Prayer Blanket, symbolizing Faith, Hope, Love and Peace, and a commitment of daily prayer by its members, our Ministry seeks to obtain healing, protection, or strength and grace for those on our Prayer Blanket Ministry List.

Membership Eligibility

Any parishioner interested in sharing in our daily prayer commitment for our recipients is welcome.

Member Responsibilities

Our ministry is composed of parishioners with diverse gifts and talents, and a shared commitment to prayer.

How many Prayer Blanket Recipients have there been?

Since our Ministry began in 2007, we have given out over 1,300 Prayer Blankets (as of Nov. 2014), averaging about 200 a year, to individuals throughout the United States and those serving in the military overseas.

How is the Ministry funded?

The Prayer Blanket Ministry is funded solely by donations.

Initially, Dar Sery, A Good Shepherd Parishioner, received a \$500.⁰⁰ check from her Oncology Radiologist to be used as “seed money” to start a Ministry of Outreach. As a cancer survivor, Dar was led through prayer to begin this Ministry in our Parish in 2007.

Since its inception, our Ministry has been funded by donations only. The average cost of a Prayer Blanket is \$10.⁰⁰.

All donations are greatly appreciated but we never ask for money. Our Ministry is a gift to all.

Who can be a Prayer Blanket Recipient?

Anyone who is in need of prayers offered for healing, protection (military), or strength and grace (clergy and religious):

- Parishioners or Non-Parishioners
- Catholics or Non-Catholics

How long is a Prayer Blanket Recipient prayed for?

Once given, a Prayer Blanket Recipient remains on our daily prayer list and we continue to pray for those who have gone on to their Eternal Resting Place.

When does the Ministry meet?

Meetings are held on the First Friday of the Month at 9:45 a.m. in the Parish Life Center, September through May, where we pray for each recipient by name.
